## 2 Introduction

Rainbow CTI & Media Bridge works with a number of telephone systems e.g. Cisco Call Manager, Avaya IP Office, NEC 3C etc. This document describes the installation of Rainbow CTI and Media Bridge for NEC IS3000.

Rainbow CTI & Media Bridge application is installed on a local machine in customer premises. It connects with Rainbow Server to push the list of extensions so that they can be associated to Rainbow Users for CTI and VOIP calling, and it also interacts with third-party telephone systems to monitor those extensions for signaling information and call controls.

This document will take you step by step through the installation process. Everything is explained in detail to get hold of the understanding of the solutions architecture.

**Note: Red Boxes and Arrows indicate the functional areas on every screen or window.**

## 3 Pre Requisites


Following configurations have to be made in the IIS configurations as pre-requisites on the machine before proceeding with Rainbow CTI & Media Bridge installation.

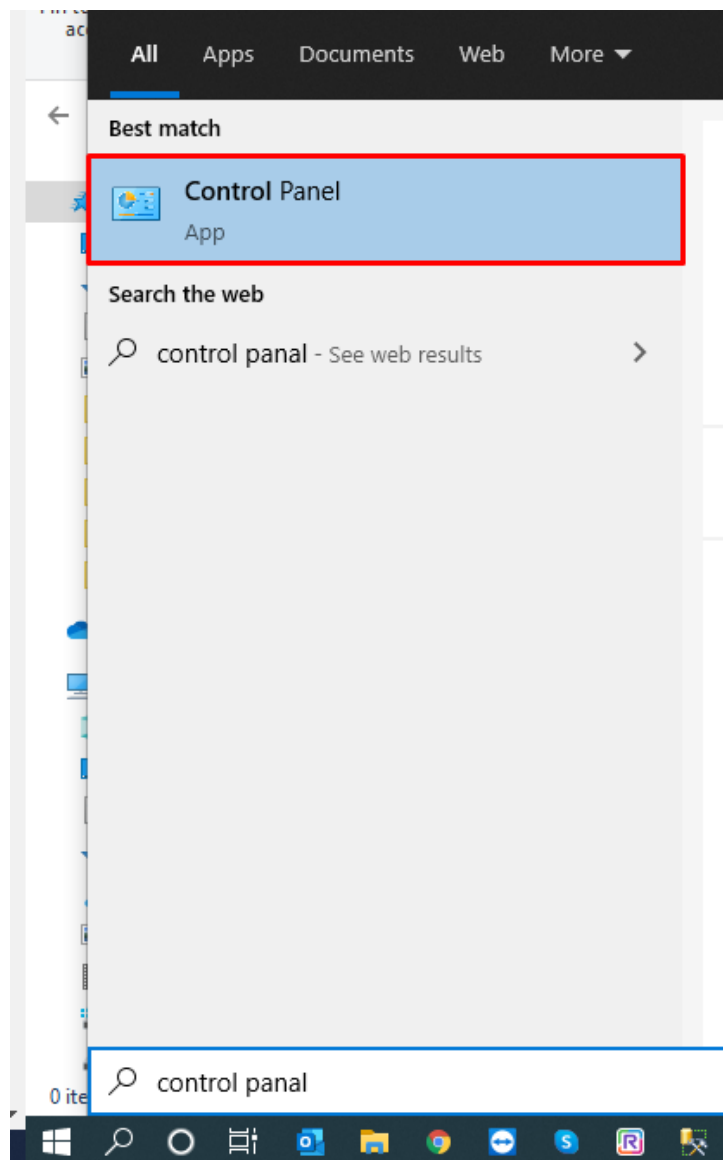
Following configurations have to be done for all applicable version of Windows i.e. Windows 10 and Windows Server 2012, 2016 & 2019.

**IMPORTANT:** *When installing the Rainbow CTI & Media Bridge, you must be logged in as a Local Administrator. Failing to do this may prevent that application from being installed correctly.*

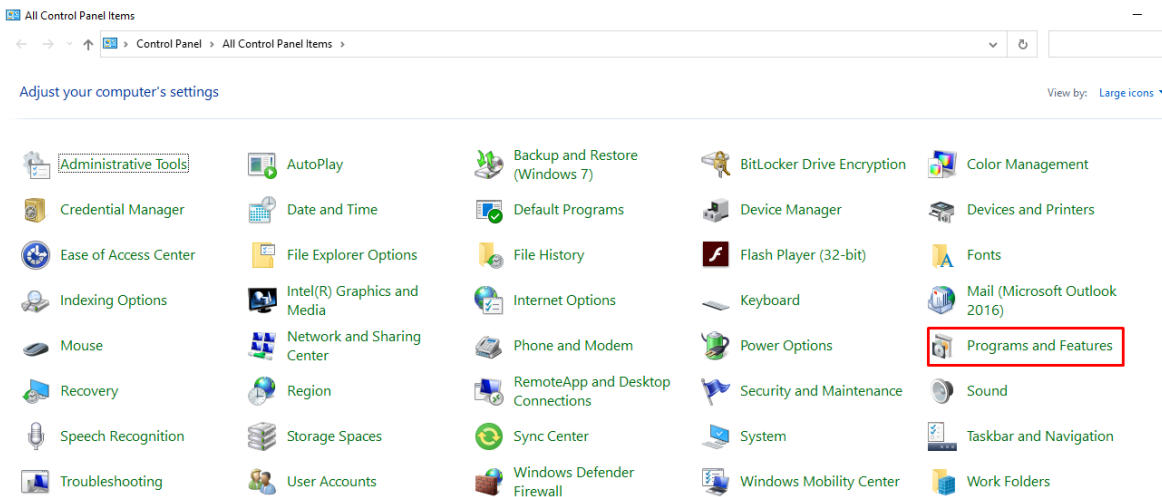
### 3.1 IIS & .NET Framework Configurations for Windows 10

Please perform following configurations of IIS & .NET Framework on a machine that is operating on Windows 10 OS prior to installation of Rainbow CTI & Media Bridge on it.

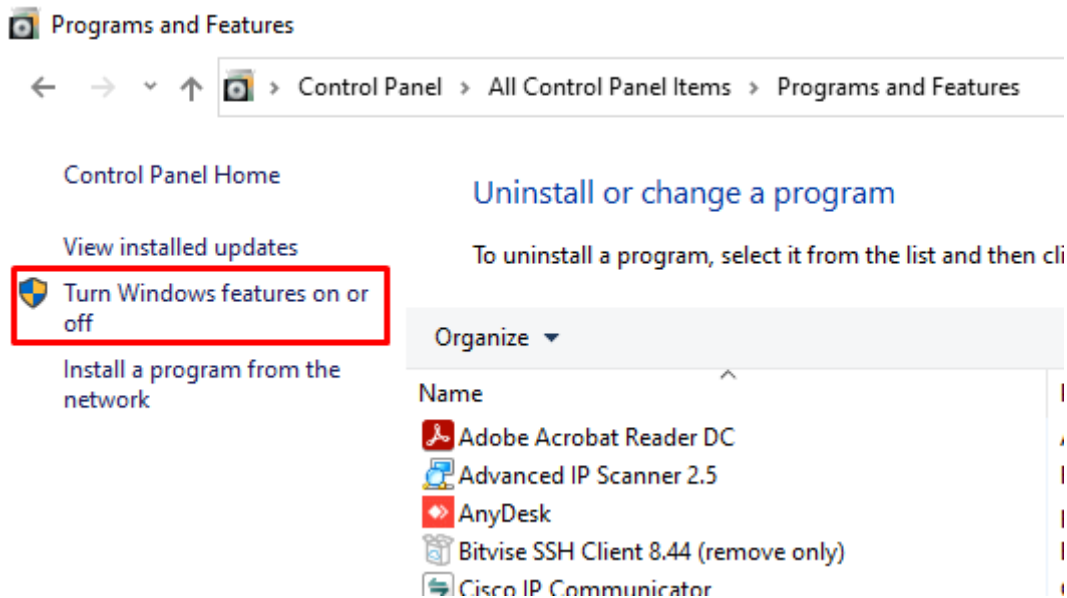
1. Click on Start Icon  and open Control Panel as displayed below:

If you are installing Rainbow CTI & Media Bridge on Windows Server 2019 and face an error while performing the above step, then following steps have to be performed to resolve this issue:

- Insert the Windows installation media in the form of either a CD or through a bootable disc format.

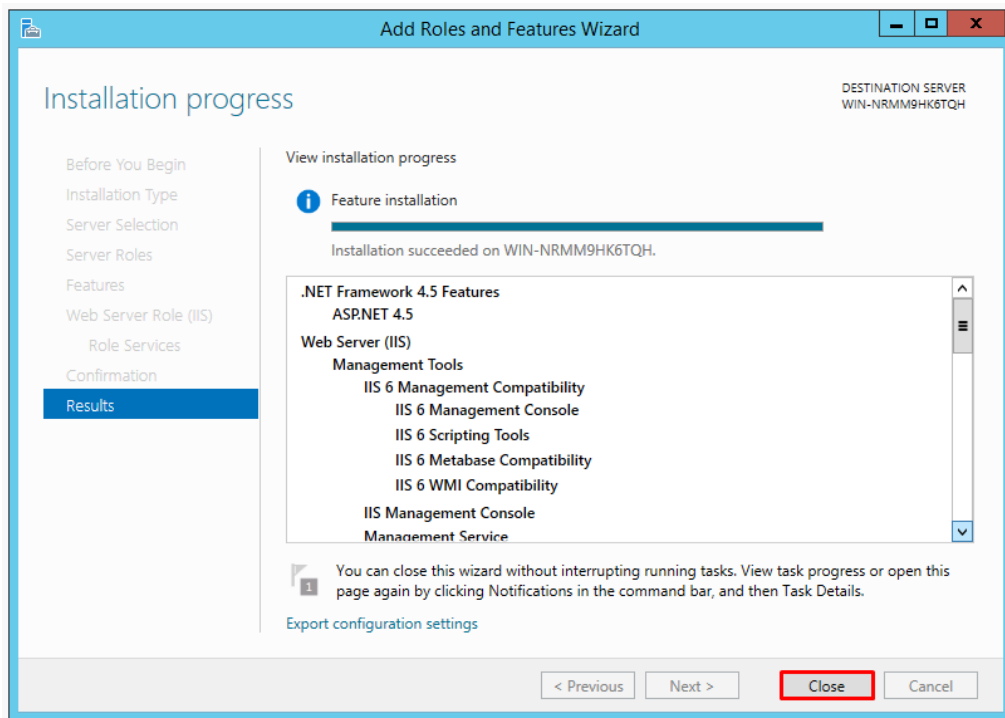
- Launch Command Prompt. You can employ multiple options to launch a command prompt, though the simplest ones would be to type in cmd in the Windows Search field.
- Type in the following command in Command Prompt interface

```
Dism /online /enable-feature /featurename:NetFX3 /All /Source:[cd drive]:\sources\sxs /LimitAccess
```

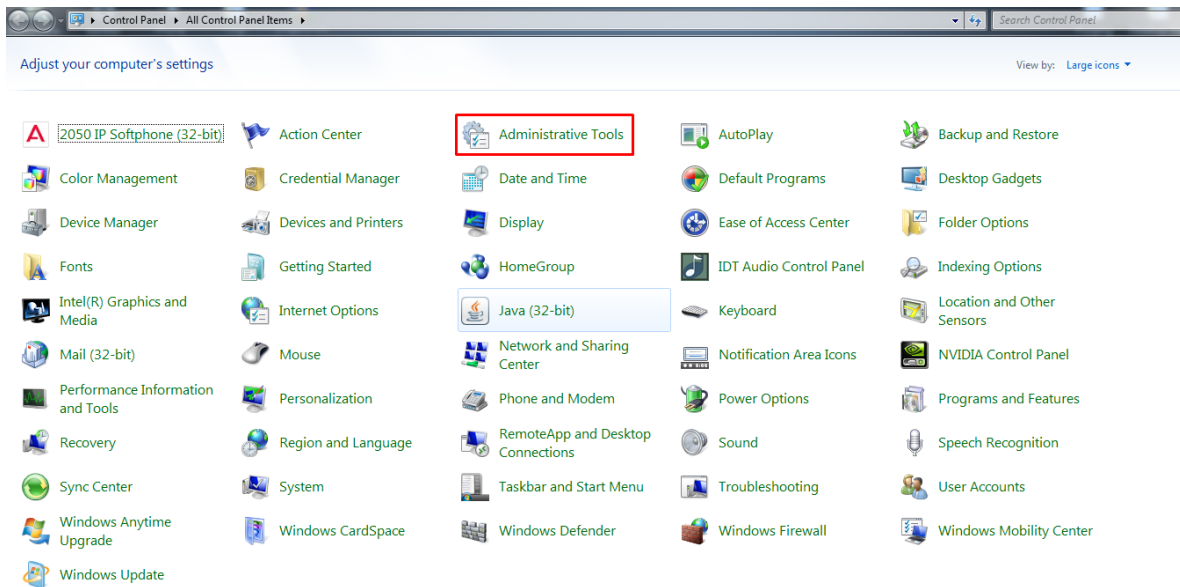
**IMPORTANT!!** Make sure that in the highlighted portion, you enter the drive name that is associated with your CD-ROM/bootable device.

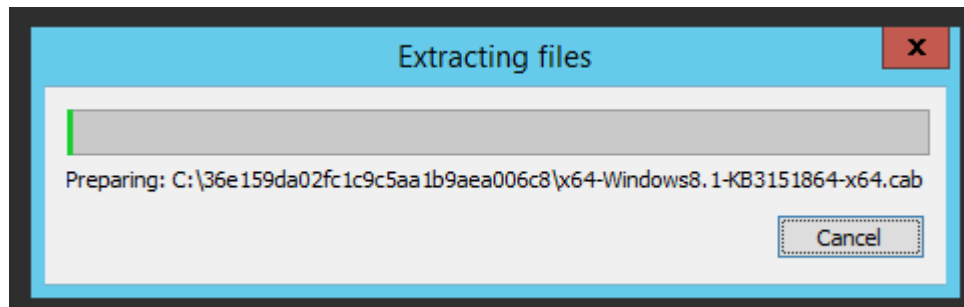
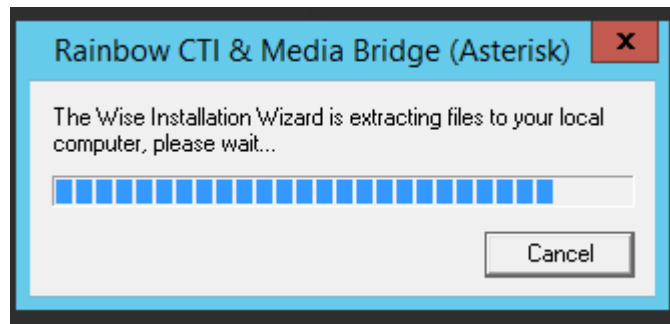
**IMPORTANT!!** Windows Defender must be turned off during installation.

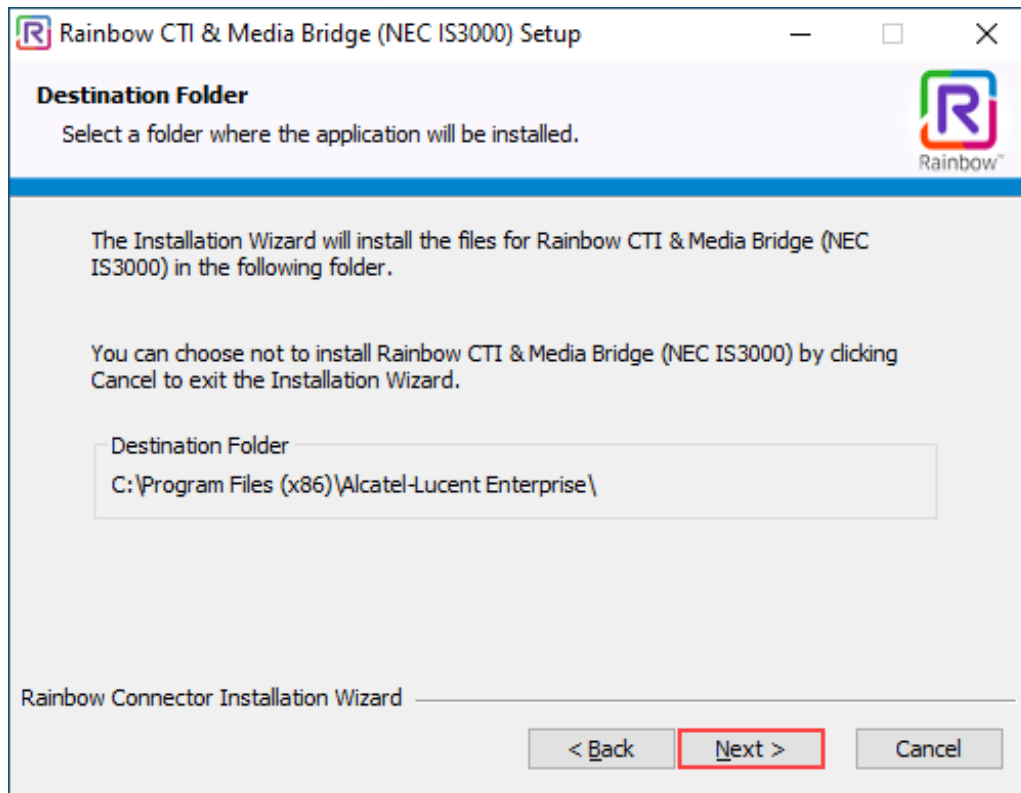

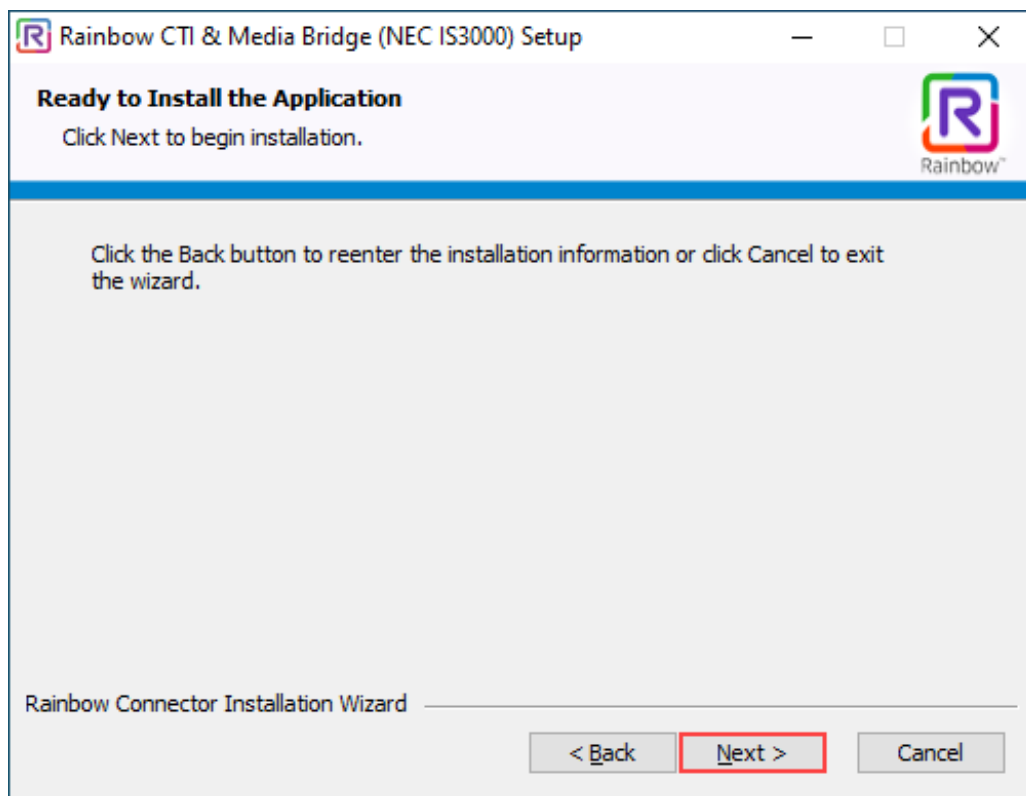

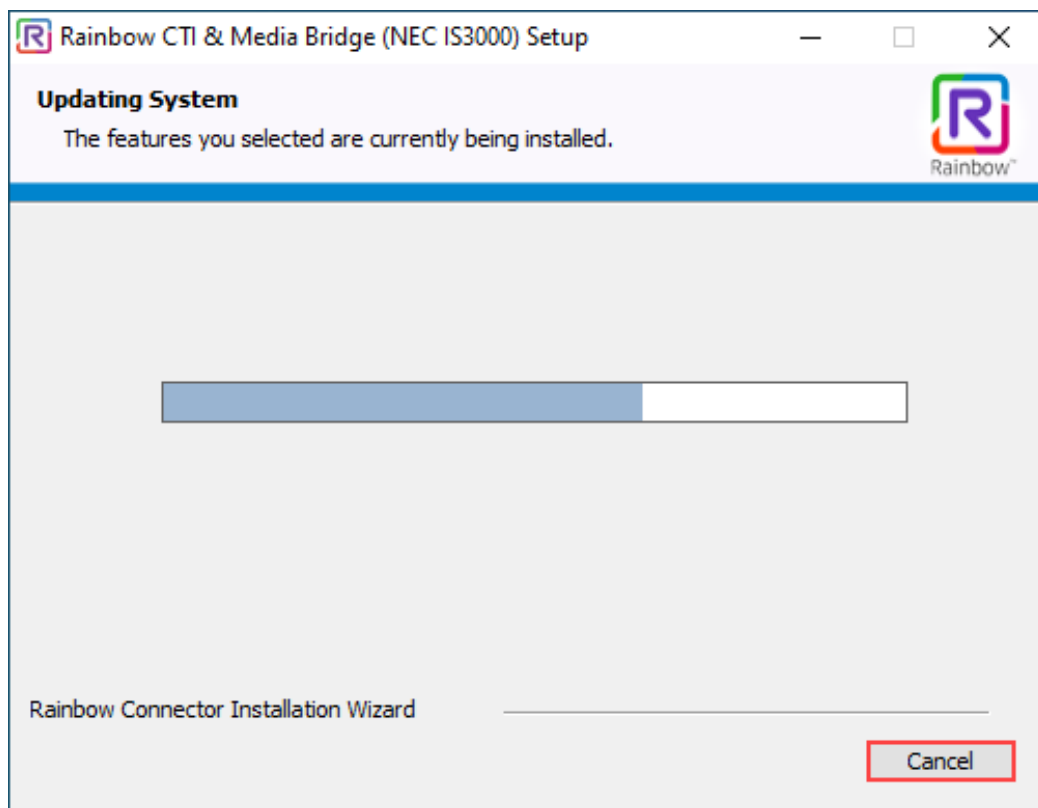

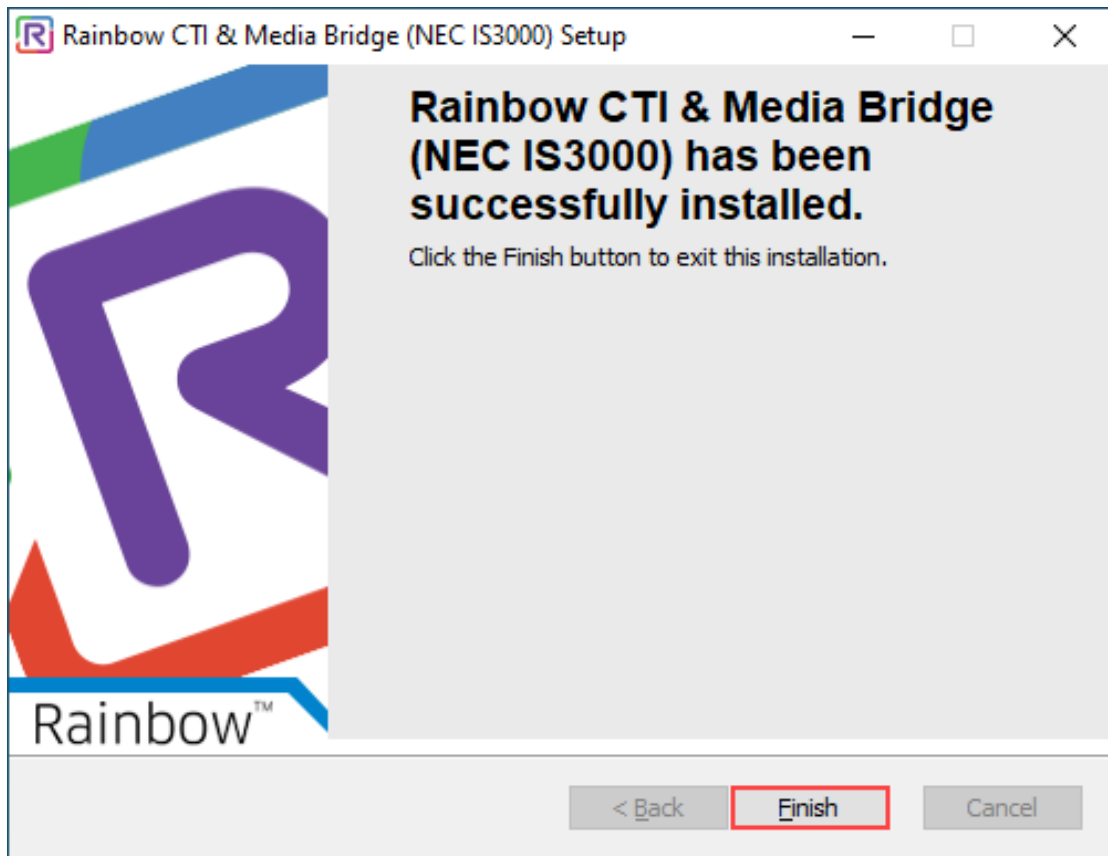
